Scripture Reading Colossians 3:1-4

- **1.** How do we and the culture struggle with "identity". What are some answers that our culture gives and how is God's way so different?
- **2.** How do you understand what it means to be united to Christ? What difference does it make?
- **3.** Discuss the way this passage defines our identity in Christ. Discuss: new life with Him, eternal security and the glory to be revealed. Embrace these truths with faith and thankfulness.
- **4.** How meaningful is it to say that we are not defined by ourselves, our past, our hurts or the passing things of this world and this age?
- **5.** How do these realities actually set us free to live and love and serve?
- **6.** Why do we need both to "seek the things that are above" and "set our minds on things that are above, not on things that are on the earth"? What does that look like? How can we make it a reality?
