Scripture Reading Philippians 3:12-4:1

- 1. What are the words Paul uses here to describe how he now lives life? What do you think they mean? How do they relate to your approach to life?
- 2. What are the things Paul actively seeks?
- 3. Is he earning His standing with God by this pursuit or is he acting out of what He has been given? What has he (and all who believe) been given? Think particularly about verses 12b, 14b and 20. How does that encourage you to press forward?
- 4. How is it helpful to be freed from the past, see verse 13?
- 5. How encouraging and ennobling is it to be a citizen of heaven with such a King and such a future?
- 6. What are ways you can apply the challenges of this passage as you approach a new year?
